

INFORMATION FOR THE AUTHORS

The details that follows are meant to clarify the structure and also the quality that our magazine expects from its authors.

The address the texts will be sent is colocviiteatral@yahoo.com

We accept articles saved as .doc format.

The works sent will be subjected to a peer-review evaluation process sustained by committed members of academic community.

The entire responsibility regarding the accuracy of empiric support, analysis and scientific interpretations, and also for the consistency of translations in English language, are ascribed to the authors.

The depositing of the manuscript implies that the article is not included in a process of evaluation/editing somewhere else.

The texts that would be presented in issue **number 21, *21st Century Theater - between utopia and pragmatism***, from *Colocvii teatrale / Theatrical Colloquia* may be:

- Research studies theme (maximum 15 pages)
- Articles on research theme (minimum 15 pages)
- Interviews
- Book reviews
- Spectacle chronicle

The texts will be written bilingual, having attached a résumé and keywords also in bilingual version (Romanian-English).

The résumés will have 10-15 written lines.

The author names will be written on the front page, on the first line and will have a footnote mentioning the office and the affiliation institution of the author.

Under the title of the text, aligned central on the page, would be written the résumé (which can have at most 15 lines), then the keywords (at most 5 keywords).

The texts will be edited on A4 page format, using Times New Roman font, with the letters seized 12.

The page edges are: top – 2,5cm; bottom – 2,5cm; left – 2,5cm; right – 2,5cm.

Page configuration will be: Normal, Single space.

The words in foreign languages will be written in Italic type.

The quotes will have quotation marks and the source must be mentioned on footnote.
The texts must present, at the end, a bibliography edited as follows:

For books:

Author's second name, the first name, title of the book, place where the book was published, the Publishing house, the year of releasing.

For articles from newspapers or magazines, the rules are:

Author's second name, the first name, the article's title, the title of newspaper/magazine, the issue number, the month of release, the place of publishing, the year of release.

For WEB articles will be specified:

The address of web site, the author, (the year), the title, web site's name, the date of download (day, month, year).
